On reaching the roundabout at the motorway junction of the M4 / A33, Junction 11.

Road improvement works have occurred at this motorway junction, to improve the flow of traffic. You need to be focused on the high level road signs & the actions of your fellow drivers.

ON THE READING SIDE OF THE M4

The new roundabout has increased in size & is now, in places, about 4 lanes wide.

DO NOT TAKE THE DUAL CARRIAGE A33 RELIEF ROAD (1st EXIT) (MADJESKI STADIUM, TOWN CENTRE & TRADING ESTATES).
After the dual carriage way to Reading (A33) - Keep in the left lane and take the B3270 (second exit) small road, signposted "Shinfield" & "Royal Berkshire Hospital, A & E Department" which runs alongside the M4 (east).

Follow the road alongside the motorway, passing "Foster Wheeler" on your left hand side.

At the next roundabout, turn LEFT onto the Shinfield Road, A327 heading towards Reading.

Keep on driving straight across 3 sets of road traffic lights (not including any pedestrian crossings).

On route you pass a weather centre, garage, pubs & various small shops, then Leighton Park School.

After the third set of lights; the entrance to the main university site is on your right.

At the next set of traffic lights (staggered junction) get into the RIGHT hand lane turn RIGHT then take an immediate left (Redlands Road) signposted "Royal Berkshire Hospital".

Drive down Redlands Road - (HILL) TAKE the 4th turning on the RIGHT Addington Road (Redlane Court is the first turning on your right).

Accommodation Office is at Redlane Court.

ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF TRANSPORT TO THE HOSPITAL.

By bus:
